The college Card is for you. It is a declining balance meal plan program for students and faculty/staff. You can sign up with \$25 or more at a cash register in the Dining Room. Your ID card is used like a bank card. By using the College Card meal program, you receive a 5% discount on all your purchases and students do not pay sales tax. Money may be added to your account anytime throughout the year in The Dining Room, Pulse Diner, Coffee Shop or Minneapolis Deli. College Card points may also be used in the Bookstore. Credit Cards are accepted at all dining locations.

Having a guest for dinner? You are welcome to bring a friend or family member with you to any meal. You must be present when your card is being used to buy meals for other people. You can use your meal plan, credit card or cash to pay for their food.

## Our Locations

Meal plans can be used at all of our locations:

### Main Dining Room

Visit us on the first floor of the Coeur De Catherine for a variety of options. For lunch and dinner selections include: Classics, International, Pasta, Grill, Salad Bar and Gourmet Salads, and Deserts. For breakfast enjoy the Cereal Bar, Waffle Bar or made to order eggs, omelets, and breakfast sandwiches.

### Pulse

The Pulse also located on first floor Coeur De Catherine offers a differentiation of hours to accommodate your needs. At this location we offer an extension of the grill in a café atmosphere with music, television and other forms of entertainment.

### Coffee Shop

At the coffee a selection of soups, salads, and sandwiches are available in addition to beverages you might find at a regular coffee shop. Some beverages include: Peace Coffee (100% Fair Trade), cappuccino, as well as fresh made smoothies. The Coffee Shop is located on the second floor of Coeur De Catherine, above the library.

### Market Place

The Market Place is the source for dorm dining and other daily needs. This convenience store is located on the second floor of Coeur De Catherine above the Main Dining Room. Items include: boxed, canned, frozen and refrigerated foods, as well as organic foods, natural foods, snacks and candy, shower needs, medicines and first aid needs, and an assortment of other items.

## Frequently Asked Questions

**Q. What happens to my bonus points if I don't use them by the end of the semester?**

A. Points remaining at the end of the semester will be forfeited. Cash register receipts give the amount of points you have left, and Meal Plan Declining Balance Guideline Chart Posted to help track your spending.

**Q. How many meals will I be able to purchase?**

A. On the Platinum Plan you have approximately \$13.00 to spend each day at any of our locations.

**Q. What if I have special diet needs?**

A. We offer lactose and Gluten free options and Vegan/vegetarian options. For assistance contact us at x6900.

**Q. If I want to purchase or increase a meal plan what do I do?**

A. You can sign up in the Dining Room or Minneapolis Deli with the cashier.

**Q. Are there healthy options and organic products available?**

A. All of our locations offer healthy selections. The Market place has a broad selection available and when possible we serve local, sustainable produce in the Dining Room.

**Q. What do I do if I lose my ID card?**

A. You must go to the Information Center on the St Paul campus or Counseling & Student Development on the Minneapolis Campus to get a new card, and you must have a card to make a purchase.
